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**PLAINTIFFS' EMERGENCY MOTION TO COMPEL
COMPLIANCE WITH PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

Plaintiffs move the Court to compel Defendant to comply with this Court's September 7, 2011 Order "requir[ing] it to take steps to enact ballot access laws that address the constitutional deficiencies identified here, in *Brunner*, and in *Blackwell*." See Docket No. 13, at 12. Specifically, Plaintiffs move the Court to alternatively compel Defendant to issue a formal Directive stating that Plaintiff-LPO and its candidates are automatically qualified for Ohio's 2012 primary and general election ballots, without petitioning, or to order that Defendant automatically include Plaintiff-LPO and its candidates on Ohio's 2012 primary and general election ballots, without petitioning.
