(pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746)

I, James N. Clymer, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am over the age of 18 and reside in Pennsylvania.
2. I have personal knowledge about the matters to which I attest.
3. I am an executive committee member and the former National Chairman of the Constitution Party National Committee, having served in that position from September, 1999 through April, 2012. I also serve as Treasurer of the Constitution Party of Pennsylvania ("CPPA").
4. On or before the August 1, 2012 deadline, CPPA submitted nomination petitions, as required by 25 P.S. § 2911(b) ("Section 2911(b)), to place our candidates on Pennsylvania's

November 6, 2012 general election ballot.

5. Secretary of the Commonwealth Aichele, through his agents and employees, reviewed the nomination petitions pursuant to 25 P.S. § 2936, and certified that they contain the number of signatures required by Section 2911(b).

6. Prior to certifying CPPA's nomination petitions, Secretary Aichele invalidated an unknown number of signatures because of unspecified technical defects, even though the signatures facially appeared to be otherwise valid.

7. I hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.

IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS
(pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746)

I, Carl Romanelli, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am over the age of 18 and reside in Pennsylvania.
2. I have personal knowledge about the matters to which I attest.
3. I am Chair of the Green Party of Pennsylvania ("GPPA"), the Pennsylvania state affiliate of the national Green Party.
4. On or before the August 1, 2012 deadline, GPPA submitted nomination petitions, as required by 25 P.S. § 2911(b) ("Section 2911(b)), to place our candidates on Pennsylvania's November 6, 2012 general election ballot.

5. Secretary of the Commonwealth Aichele reviewed the nomination petitions pursuant to 25 P.S. § 2936, and certified that they contain the number of signatures required by Section 2911(b).

6. Prior to certifying GPPA's nomination petitions, Secretary Aichele invalidated an unknown number of signatures because the signers did not include the year 2012 in the date they signed the petitions, or because of other minor technicalities, even though the signatures were otherwise valid.

7. The nomination petitions required by Section 2911(b) must be obtained from Secretary Aichele's office. Each petition indicates, in the bottom left corner, that it was revised in January 2012.

4. On or before the August 1, 2012 deadline, LPPA submitted nomination petitions, as required by 25 P.S. § 2911(b) ("Section 2911(b)), to place our candidates on Pennsylvania's November 6, 2012 general election ballot.

5. Secretary of the Commonwealth Aichele reviewed the nomination petitions pursuant to 25 P.S. § 2936, and certified that they contain the number of signatures required by Section 2911(b).
